The purpose of this letter to is offer support to you for the “Beach Lakes Acquisition and Restoration” project.

I understand that you would like community support and are asking for involvement. We, the Building Association, are interested in helping where we can and would like to donate time and service (To be determined upon successful acquisition of the property.)

Some of the support we could offer would be the dismantling (and possible re-use/re-purposing of materials back to the site) of the structures as well as site clearing and rock removal.

We may be able to also assist in the building of the restroom facilities and development of the crushed rock footpaths as well.

I know that grant participants are asked to pledge dollar amounts to a project, since we do not have a set of plans to determine exactly what is needed (and I believe that the project is in development and dynamic) I cannot state a dollar figure that we can commit to. However, given what I know of the site, typically the cost to demo the type of buildings you have there could run 35-60k including dump fees; this is a general figure and certainly could go higher if upon inspection asbestos and or lead is discovered.

We want to be involved and as soon as you have a definitive plan please get it to me and I will rally the association and get you hard figures on the value of our services.
