



Mr. McSherry,

Skamania County Public Works is pleased to provide this letter as evidence of match (Donated Materials) for the Port of Skamania's (Port) Aquatic Lands Enhancement Account (ALEA) funding for the project referenced above. The County will make available, at no cost, approximately 18,000 cubic yards (cy) of rock and soil and 13 trees deposited by a landslide known as the Piper Road Landslide on Rock Creek in Stevenson Washington. Additionally, the Port and its contractors will be given access to the County's Home Valley rock quarry for additional materials, if needed.

The estimated value of soil, rock and trees are as follows:
