SUMMARY OF WORK PERFORMED

For the week ending 7/17/15, ESA:

- 1) Attended weekly construction meeting;
- 2) Performed On-Site archaeological monitoring within the Archaeologically Sensitive Area (ASA) during:
 - a. sod removal and grubbing within ASA - east and south of Farm House
 - b. removal of Bunk House and Farm House foundations (moved forward in schedule).

RESULTS

No archaeological artifacts or features, or other potential cultural indicators, such as charcoal, burned soils, or fire modified rocks, were observed.

COMMENTS

McCann Construction also grubbed outside of the ASA, and continued aboveground demolition; this work was not actively monitored by ESA.

UPCOMING SCHEDULE

For the week of 7/20-7/24/15, ESA anticipates conducting On-Site monitoring during contaminated soil removal within the ASA. Depending upon progress, archaeologically-directed mechanical excavation (i.e., mitigation during mass excavation) may also begin this week.
