But if there is a chance you might want to use cultural resources as part of your match requirement then please leave it as part of the scope of work and include it in your project budget.
Overall Project Metrics	If match may include previously funded conceptual or preliminary design work then make sure the project description and proposal includes that work in the scope. Your project proposal, cost estimate, and other application materials should include match activities plus work funded by the SRFB.

Attachments	<p>Will an MOA be required between different divisions of KC to realize this restoration project? For example when Seattle SPU has a project on Seattle Parks property there is a signed MOA necessary before construction begins. If such a doc will be needed for this project, considering including that as one of the project deliverables -- akin to a landowner agreement.</p> <p>Cost estimate: Just want to confirm that the cost estimate for the SRFB scope of work will afford completion of the design deliverables outlined in Manual 18 Appendix D-3.</p> <p>Usually see more line item detail in a design budget of this magnitude. Are all of your site investigations complete (geotech, etc)? Community engagement is a part of which line item? Please provide more detail, at least include line items for the tasks included in the scope of work narrative (p 7) of your salmon proposal. Would also be helpful to annotate the budget with the information included in the budget narrative on p 7, by adding the total estimated hours and wage rate used to calculate the cost.</p> <p>Salmon proposal should have track changes to show what has been adjusted since site visits. Also need to respond to review panel.</p>

SUBMIT APPLICATION

Submit Application	If you can complete this scope of work by June 30, 2018 then the county can change this to a \$0

match grant, as the request is for \$200K or less.

Just need to update the cost estimate and the prism metrics accordingly.
