PROJECT SUMMARY *(for Review Panel reference only)*

This acquisition project will acquire almost 12 acres and just over 1,000 feet of marine shoreline bordering the Maury Island Aquatic Reserve in South Central Puget Sound. Acquisition of these three parcels will allow for the future removal of about 375 feet of shoreline armoring and reconnect historic feeder bluffs with the nearshore. This is primarily a chinook salmon recovery project targeting eelgrass, marine nearshore, and forage fish spawning habitat. All sites have “high potential” for enhancement in PSNERP’s Strategies for Nearshore Protection and Restoration in Puget Sound.
