PRELIMINARY DESCRIPTION OF KING COUNTY PROPOSAL

The project will construct Segment A of the Lake to Sound (L2S) Trail, which runs from the Green River Trail near Fort Dent Park in the City of Tukwila through the Black River Riparian Forest to Naches Avenue SW in the City of Renton. Segment A of the L2S Trail will be 1.2 miles in length and will include construction of a 12-foot-wide paved, non-motorized, shared use path with 2-foot-wide gravel shoulders. Project improvements include a new 110-foot pedestrian bridge across the Black River and a street crossing with a pedestrian-activated flashing beacon at Monster Road.
