#### ADVISORY COMMITTEE COMMENTS

Although this project was not presented at technical review here are some general comments from the advisory committee that apply to all presentations:

- Number slides.
- Include a north arrow and scale on all maps.
- Ensure maps are big enough to read. One map on one slide is good. Don't try and put too much on one slide.
- Label each slide with the number and criteria question you are answering so the advisory committee always knows which criteria question they are answering.
- Don't spend too much time on your introduction as you don't get points for your introduction. Limit to introducing yourself, orientate them to the location of the project so they know where they are, and tell them what you want to do with the grant funds.
- Don't use too much text on your slides. Advisory committee tries to read it all instead of listening to what you're saying. Use maps and pictures where you can to help answer the criteria question and bullet points to highlight what you are saying.

It should read that it's coming from federal grant(s) and voter approved levy, per the grant application. I either need the minutes from the council indicating this was the intent and that it's simply a typo in the resolution, or I will need a new authorizing resolution.</li> <li>•Control and tenure is still questionable. I see throughout the application that control and tenure will need to be obtained, but it's not clear by whom. It appears as though it's from Renton, Tukwila, BNSF and Union Pacific? It's not expected that control and tenure will be obtained during the grant application phase, but it will need to be obtained before a grant agreement is executed, if funded, and I need a clear picture of the ownership within the project area so it can be clarified in the application for evaluators.</li> </ul>
