The Port of Grays Harbor is requesting an amendment to the current project agreement to allow the Port to bill A&E costs up to the program limit of 20%. The limit in the current agreement is 5% which was included in the original application.

As explained in the previously approved time extension, the project has required additional engineering support to address several issues related to permitting and changes in regulations since the project was originally designed. We understand the increase of the allowable A&E expenses does not increase the total grant amount but just the amount of A&E that can be reimbursed.
